TWMA - TarraWarra Museum of Art, Yarra Valley

This museum is a compulsory visit for everyone interested in the development of *Australian Contemporary Art*. It is the only privately funded museum in *Australia*, built to house the collection of benefactors Eva and Marc Bensen.

TarraWarra Museum of Art exhibits artists from the 1950's onwards. The collection demonstrates the unique Australian character, in an architectural showcase building that is one of the highlights of the *Yarra Valley*.

Designed by leading *Australian* architect Allan Powell, in a competition, it elegantly arcs round the hill, in affinity with the landscape.

It's worth a trip to experience the building. It has won many prizes for its innovative design: it sits harmoniously beside the *TarraWarra Estate Winery and Wine café*, where you can celebrate your *Australian cultural* experience afterwards, in style.

The exhibitions are curated in tandem with the seasons, focusing on facets of the collection, or using it as impetus for an examination of a wider selection of art.

Take your time in this special place. It offers a nurturing retreat from urban life in the *Australian* landscape and cultural heart.
